- 1. I decline to prosecute.
- 2. There is no reasonable prospect of successful prosecution.
- 3. A1's allegations against the two suspects are based on the article in the Eye Witness News.
- 4. A1 has no personal knowledge of the alleged commission of the offences.
- 5. On the 01 April 2014 the suspect and Eskom entered into a written contract to supply coal.
- 6. On 31 March 2016 the contract was terminated.

7. There is no evidence to corroborate the allegations

by A1 that the confirmation by Singh of paying the

amount of R500.000.00 into the ANCYL was to

assist in receiving a further Eskom contract.

8. The suspect Mr Collen Maine confirms that he

approached Mr Joe Singh to contribute financially

to the ANCYL and the alleged amount was paid into

their Organisation's fund raising account. Based on

the Section 236 bank account, contrary to what A1

alleges/suspects there is no evidence to suggest

that there were any further payments of these

amount to any other individuals.

9. There are three signatories to the ANCYL FNB

account, Collen Maine, Njabulo Nzuza and Reggie

Nkabinde. Neither of the three signatories

personally benefited financially from the alleged

amount deposited into the account.
