RE: YOUR COMPLAINT

Receipt of your complaint is acknowledged with thanks.

The South African Human Rights Commission ('Commission') is a state institution established by Chapter 9 of the Constitution to support constitutional democracy. The Commission is mandated in terms of section 184 of the Constitution to promote the protection, development and attainment of human rights, and to monitor and assess the observance of such rights within the Republic of South Africa. Complaints handling is a core function of the Legal Services Programme of the Commission and it includes investigation of violation of human rights provided for in Chapter 2 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996.

Your complaint has been referred to the Provincial Manager for assessment in order to determine whether a human right has been violated; whether the Commission has jurisdiction to investigate the matter; whether it should be referred to or could be dealt with more effectively or expeditiously by another organisation, institution, statutory body or institution created by the Constitution or any applicable legislation or whether the complaint should be accepted on the grounds that it contains a prima facie violation of a human right. If it appears that a human right has been violated, the matter will be forwarded to the Legal Services Programme for investigation and a member of the said Programme will contact you in due course, for further investigation of the complaint.

You will be kept informed of the progress in the matter on at least a monthly basis and on conclusion of the investigation, you will be informed accordingly.
