Sir,

The subject matter bears reference.

This school was partially destroyed by a wind storm on the 16 July 2019. There has been no response from the department to date, as far as I am informed.

The grades 5 and 6 are accommodated in a hall but I am told that the walls are falling down. Some learners are being taught in a nearby church!

Please see the appended pictures to comprehend the urgent nature of the matter at hand. You will acknowledge that there is no time to waste. I must ask why this has taken so long to receive attention, if any, and who has been sitting on their hands?

I am uncertain if this school is considered to be 'small and unviable'. Even if it so, the learning and teaching conditions must be imminently addressed. To do this, the department must dispatch 'park-homes' or 'mobile classrooms' in the interim – or any other immediate measure - to ensure that everyone is safe.

I am hopeful that you will give this matter the urgent attention it deserves.
