INVESTIGATION: THE APPOINTMENT OF STAFF MEMBERS AND/OR CONSULTANTS IN THE PRIVATE OFFICE OF THE MINISTER OF WATER AND SANITATION AND HUMAN SETTLEMENTS; AND, THE NATIONAL DEPARTMENT OF WATER AND SANITION AND HUMAN SETTLEMENTS' NATIONAL RAPID RESPONSE TASK TEAM (NRRTT).

Your complaint lodged with the Public Service Commission (PSC) in the above regard, dated 23 January 2020, refers.

The PSC analysed the complaint and determined that the matter pertains to the alleged irregular conduct of the Minister of Human Settlements, Water and Sanitation. Kindly note that the investigation of the conduct of Executive Authorities (EAs) such as the Minister of Human Settlements, Water and Sanitation does not fall within the ambit of the mandate of the PSC.

However, in accordance with the *Public Protector Act, 1994*, the Public Protector is mandated to investigate the conduct of EAs. In addition, section 4(1) of the *Executive Members' Ethics Act, 1998*, stipulates that the Public Protector must investigate an alleged breach of the code of ethics on receipt of any complaint by, amongst others, the President, a member of the National Assembly or a permanent delegate to the National Council of Provinces, if the complaint is against a Cabinet member or a Deputy Minister.



With due regard to the above, the matter was referred to the Public Protector for further handling.

The PSC regards the matter as closed.
