

1	Social distancing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure work desks are distanced according to the 1m guideline</li> <li>• Access to the play areas (inside/outside) to be staggered</li> </ul>
2.	Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Mandatory cloth masks or face shields for ECD at all times. Cloth masks are to be washed regularly, while visors are to be sanitized daily.</li> <li>• Children: infants not to wear masks. Toddlers over 2 years to wear masks or Perspex full-face shields.</li> <li>• Working thermometer in every classrooms (temperatures of staff and children to be checked on regular intervals daily).</li> <li>• Hand sanitizers and soap to be readily available.</li> <li>• Plastic aprons for children to be put on children on upon entry and taken off when they exit.</li> </ul>
3.	Classroom and play area	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• ECD centres to be professionally sanitized before receiving any children.</li> <li>• Surfaces sanitized in bathrooms and kitchens to be sanitized regularly.</li> <li>• Play area equipment to be sanitized daily.</li> <li>• Dedicated area to wash hands. In case of no sink and running water, a bucket/basin must be available.</li> <li>• Full length Perspex dividers to section off classroom.</li> <li>• Means to create ventilation.</li> </ul>
4.	Children per class	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Limit of child per class depend on floor area per square meter of the centre.</li> </ul>
5.	Covid-19 awareness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Age appropriate awareness posters to be visible.</li> <li>• Hands sanitized and temperature monitored when entering school premises and classrooms.</li> <li>• Psychosocial support for both ECD staff and children.</li> </ul>
6.	Dropping and collection of children	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Children to be dropped at the entrance where ECD practitioners will collect them.</li> <li>• Collection of children will take place at the entrance.</li> <li>• Parents/caregivers are not to enter the premises.</li> <li>• The temperature of the child must be taken in the presence of the parent or guardian on arrival. Should the child present with high temperature, child cannot be allowed entry and it is the parent/guardian's responsibility to find alternative care</li> <li>• On arrival, all staff and children must be screened daily.</li> <li>• Symptoms of Covid-19 that could appear in a period of 2-14 days should be well known to all.</li> </ul>
7.	Sick bay	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Centers should make provision for a sick bay or a designated area away from the other children until collected by responsible adult.</li> <li>• Emergency contact details of every child.</li> <li>• Should the ECD practitioner register a high temperature on the day – alternative care solution.</li> </ul>
