Whether he has found that all personal protective equipment and other items purchased by the SA Police Service (SAPS) in relation to the Covid-19 pandemic were (a) procured at market value and (b) not procured from any SAPS member and/or a family relative of an SAPS member; if not, what is the position in this regard; if so, what are the relevant details?



REPLY:

(a) The personal protective equipment (PPE) and other items, which were purchased by the South African Police Service (SAPS), in relation to the COVID-19 pandemic, were procured at market value and according to the National Treasury Instruction Price List. However, in cases where the suppliers were out of stock, other suppliers, who confirmed the immediate availability and supply of stock and whose prices were above the National Treasury Instruction Price List, were approached.

(b) Based on the declaration of interest certificates (SBD-4), which are submitted by service providers, no orders were placed with SAPS members and/or family relatives of SAPS members.


