Rhino poaching remains a massive issue within KZN, seriously endangering the population of this endangered species.

- HOW MANY RHINO WERE POACHED IN EZEMVELO RESERVES IN 2021?
   Response: 97
- 2. HOW MANY RHINO HAVE BEEN POACHED IN EZEMVELO KZN WILDLIFE RESERVES BETWEEN 1 JANUARY 2022 AND 25 MARCH 2022?

  Response: 61
- 3. TO WHAT DOES EDTEA AND EZEMVELO ATTRIBUTE THESE POACHING INCIDENTS?

Response: Ezemvelo attributes these poaching incidents to a number of reasons which include: capacity constraints, limited funding, adjacent community's vulnerability to being enticed to collude and more organized criminal networks.
