(a) The total number of reservists in each province per category (i) from 2011/2012 financial year to date (ii) is indicated in the information and tables below:

It must be noted that all figures included in the tables below were obtained from the PERSAP System.

- Table 1 indicates the number of reservists per Province from 2011 to 2014.
 - During this period National Instruction 1/2002 determined the establishment of the Reserve Police Service.
 - 4 Categories of reservists existed during this period namely:
 - Category A Reservists: Functional Policing
 - Category B Reservists: Support Services
 - Category C Reservists: Specialized Functional Policing
 - Category D Reservists: Rural and Urban Safety

- The National Instruction was reviewed with a view to enhance the existing standards and quality of reservists in order to protect the integrity of the South African Police Service and to re-establish a professional reservist system. On 1 March 2014, National Instruction 3 of 2014 was approved and the categories of reservists were amended as follows:
 - Category 1: Functional Policing
 - Category 2: Specialised Operational Support
- The transitional process for the implementation of National Instruction 3 of 2014 commenced in 2014 and from Table 2 below, the phasing out of the old categories and the phasing in of the new categories, are evident.

(b) Reservists are volunteers and may decide at any time to terminate their services. Certain categories of employment, for example in the security or taxi industry, are excluded from the reservist system, which necessitates a reservist to resign, should they be employed in such a capacity.

Many reservists joined when they were unemployed and resign as reservists when they secure employment. A significant portion of reservists were permanently employed as SAPS members or civilian employees, as part of a targeted recruitment decision by the SAPS to consider reservists who are eligible for employment.

The amendment of the National Instruction, specifically changes to the categories of reservists and the enhanced criteria for recruitment, led to a reduction in the numbers of reservists.

During the transitional phase (from 2014) many reservists were found to be inactive but were still reflected on the PERSAP System. Provinces were requested to conduct a thorough verification process in order to update the system for accurate and verified information.

The SAPS commenced with the recruitment of new reservists in the 2018/2019, 2019/2020 and 2020/2021 financial years, during which 3 628 reservists were appointed.
