

## NATIONAL ASSEMBLY DRAFT RESOLUTION

## **Motion:**

I hereby move on behalf of the Democratic Alliance that the House:

- Notes the turmoil reported between the senior members of the African National Congress, many of whom occupy positions in the National Executive, since the release of the Report of the Section 89 Independent Panel appointed to conduct a preliminary enquiry on the motion proposing a section 89 inquiry, which has allegedly suspended and paralysed the public service and placed our country at a political crossroads;
- 2. Acknowledges that in a democracy, it should be the people who decide the future path of the country through an electoral mandate;
- 3. Recognises that the Republic's human development has declined rapidly under the current Government;
- 4. Further acknowledges that the policies and actions of the current Government since May 2019 have resulted in the -
  - (a) creation of record unemployment rates;
  - (b) an abject failure to meet the Republic's energy needs, which has led to economicallycrippling rolling electricity blackouts; and
  - (c) the rapid onset of humanitarian decline as more and more citizens are forced to live below the poverty line and suffer from malnourishment, widespread childhood stunting and even death as a result;
- 5. Recalls that three years have passed since the Assembly was elected;
- 6. Further notes that section 50(1) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996, provides that the President must dissolve the Assembly if the Assembly has adopted a resolution to dissolve with a supporting vote of a majority of its Members;
- 7. Resolves -

- (a) To dissolve the National Assembly in terms of section 50(1) of the Constitution; and
- (b) To suspend Rule 333(2) and Rule 351(2) to prevent Bills and other business from lapsing when the Assembly is dissolved.
