Abandoned calls:

These are the calls, which could not be answered, e.g. callers who end the calls themselves, while in the queue, before the system could transfer the call to the call-takers.

• Calls abandoned in 10 seconds:

These are the calls, which are terminated by the caller within a period of 10 seconds, before the call could be transferred to a call-taker.

• Calls abandoned in more than 10 seconds:

These are the calls, which are terminated by the caller after a period of 10 seconds, before the call could be to insferred to a call-taker.

Calls abandoned at agents:

These are the calls, which are terminated by the caller and have already been transferred to a call-taker to answer.
