2782. Mrs M O Clarke (DA) to ask the Minister of Police:

- (1) With regard to the Germiston Police Station, (a) what total number of vehicles does the specified police station have on record and (b)(i) what number of the specified vehicles are in for repairs at the police garage in Benoni and (ii) for what length of time have the vehicles been at the garage for repair;
- (2) whether any confirmation can be provided as to what number of the vehicles have been returned to the garage for repairs; if not, why not; if so, what was the length of time during secondary repairs;
- (3) what total number of police officers at the Germiston Police Station have attended advanced driving courses;
- (4) what has the accident rate and/or ratio been at the specified police station?

REPLY:

- (1)(a) The Germiston Police Station has a total of 65 vehicles.
- (b)(i) On 25 November 2020, a total of 15 vehicles were at the police garage in Benoni, for repairs.
- (b)(ii) The length of time that the vehicles have been in the garage, ranges from two to 226 days, depending upon the type of service/repairs required.
- (2) No vehicles have been returned for secondary repairs.
- (3) A total of 10 police officers, at the Germiston Police Station, have attended advanced driving courses.
- (4) The Germiston Police Station had a total of seven accidents in the current financial year, which is a ratio of one accident, per month.
