What (a) are the details of all persons who have been charged and/or convicted of (i) attempted murder, (ii) murder and (iii) drive-by shooting that have taken place in ward 10 of the Inkosi Langalibalele Local Municipality in KwaZulu-Natal from 1 January 2019 to 31 December 2022 and (b) measures have been and/or will be put in place by the SA Police Service to prevent any further attempted murders, murders and drive-by shootings in the specified ward?

REPLY:

- (a)(i) Attempted Murder - no cases reported and no convictions.
 (a)(ii) Murder - three cases were reported with no convictions.
 (a)(iii) Drive-by shootings - no cases reported and no convictions.

Details of the persons who were charged and/or convicted, with regard to the abovementioned three murder cases, are reflected in the table below:

Police station and case number	Details of persons arrested and charged
Estcourt CAS 92/08/2019	Ayanda Mshengu, 26 years old. The case is at pending in Pietermaritzburg High Court
Estcourt CAS 13/06/2020	No arrests
Estcourt CAS 66/11/2022	No arrests

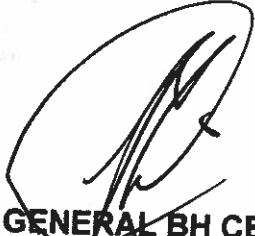
- Hot-spot areas in Ward 10 are patrolled regularly.
