The school has two mobile classrooms that are being used for Grade R classrooms. One of these mobile classrooms requires repairs that will be implemented as part of the repair works that the implementing agent is procuring the contractor for.

The mobile classrooms are going to be repaired as part of the repair works to the school facilities. Regular inspection and maintenance or replacement of the mobile classrooms will be done while the construction of the permanent structures for Grade R classrooms is being planned and implemented.
