CIVIC VOTER EDUCATION PROGRAMME - uMshwathi 20 February 2024

Madam Speaker,

While there are matters beyond the control of the Legislature such as community unrest or protests and the unavailability of Home Affairs on the particular days of these programmes, it is highly unacceptable that the ANC pitches up to campaign – quite openly and audaciously – at a Legislature event.

I am aware that there is a by-election in the ward that this programme was scheduled in.

The ANC candidate pitched up, in full party regalia, with an ANC braded vehicle, and began freely frolicking with residents as if this was his campaign event. Upon my ire and complaining to the Chief Whip on more than one occasion, he wore a coat over his ANC T-Shirt and persisted in his engagements until he was finally put in his place.
