## **WRITTEN REPLY**

MR HU DE BOER (DA) TO ASK THE MEC FOR ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, TOURISM AND ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS:

The Virginia Bush Nature Reserve (Virginia Bush) – situated in Adelaide Tambo Drive (Wards 36) Durban North is a popular natural area, and part of the DMOSS system. New information suggests developers have made application to develop a portion of this reserve into a higher end "eco estate".

1. HAS EDTEA OR ANY OF ITS ENTITIES RECEIVED ANY ENQUIRIES, EIA APPLICATIONS OR APPLICATIONS FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF VIRGINIA BUSH?

Yes, EDTEA received a request to intervene on Virgina Bush Nature Reserve's proposed development due to a disagreement between the local authority and the developers.

2. IF SO, WHAT HAS BEEN THE RESPONSE OF EDTEA TO SUCH QUERIES?

EDTEA did meet with the developers. This meeting was followed by a meeting with the developer, officials from EThekwini Metro and the MEC for EDTEA. The MEC advised the developers and eThekwini to further engage on this matter.

3. HAS ETHEKWINI MUNICIPALITY CONSULTED WITH EDTEA, KZN ENVIRONMENTAL AFFAIRS OR ANY OTHER ENTITIES REGARDING THE POTENTIAL DEVELOPMENT OF VIRGINIA BUSH?

No consultation was made by eThekwini, however EDTEA is aware that eThekwini Metro and the developer are continuing with engagements accompanied by site visits to find a sustainable solution on this matter.

EDTEA will provide its comments during the commenting period. It is worthy to note that EDTEA is not intending to interfere with the processes since the activity in question is within the mandate of the local authority.
