2. Mr L Kruger to ask the MEC responsible for Cooperative Governance and Traditional Affairs:

With regard to the Kiwane Resort located in the Buffalo City Metropolitan Municipality (BCMM):

- (1) (a) Can the department provide the name of the architects who designed the resort and (b) what was the cost of the actual resort, including (i) chalets, (ii) the restaurant, (iii) brick paving driveway and (iv) parking area, (v) braai facilities, bedding, lounge furniture, (vi) kitchen equipment and (vii) recreational equipment;
- (2) Can the MEC provide a comprehensive report on (a) the name of the company which was awarded the tender for the laundering of linen at the resort, (b) the bid opening register of the tender and (c) the terms of the contract;
- (3) (a) How much has the municipality budgeted for maintenance of the Kiwane Resort and (b) how much has been spent for the financial year of; (i) 2022/23, (ii) 2023/24, (iii) 2024/25;
- (4) How much has the department spent to date on the 4 km of road resurfaced by the BCMM;
- (5) How much has the Provincial government spent on the upgrading, gravelling and maintenance of the 10km of roads owned between the date of 2021 and June 2025;
- (6) Noting that the Municipality has commenced with upgrading the line, (a) how much was budgeted for the designs, (b) how much was allocated for the designs and (c) what is the name of the contractor appointed;
- (7) How many beds are available for guests visiting Kiwane Family Resort;
- (8) What was the occupancy rate for the period; (i) 2021/22, (ii) 2023/24 and 2024/25;
- (9) (a) Has the Buffalo City Metropolitan Municipality incurred a fine from the Department of Economic Development, Environmental Affairs and Tourism (DEDEAT) with respect to the resort, If so, (b) how much was the fine and (c) how much has BCMM paid to date;
- (10) Can the municipality provide a description of the tourism marketing tools used by BCMM to attract visitors to the resort;

- (11) How many (a) permanent staff and (b) temporary staff are employed at the resort;
- (12) Has the municipality secured a successful bidder for the running of the restaurant, if not, why not?
