(8) (a) what measures has his Department put in place with a view to ensuring the security of prisoners and (b) whether these measures can be deemed successful; if not, why?

**Response:**

(a)

- Police Safety meetings are conducted quarterly during which Risk & Integrity Management provide risks of escape.
- Resource requirements such as handcuffs, leg irons, padlocks for vehicles are identified.
- Monthly PCCF meetings are held during which escapes are discussed and consequential management is highlighted.
- For transparency purposes, every case of escaping is followed by a case of aiding so that circumstances can be thoroughly investigated.
- The National Plan to prevent escapes in police custody as well as the Provincial Order was communicated again during 2025.
